

Training Announcement

Concealed Carry for Law Enforcement

This eight hour MCOLES approved training program will strengthen your ability to carry and accurately deploy your semi-automatic handgun in a non-uniformed capacity. Emphasis will be on equipment selection, concealment techniques and weapon deployment from different types of concealment clothing and holsters. All drills will be fired from the three or nine o'clock waist position. There will be a heavy focus on improving accuracy; speed and developing effective combat shooting techniques. As a prerequisite, all students shall be expected to be confident in the safe handling of firearms and basic handgun techniques.

Participants will conduct live fire drills using under full and low light conditions utilizing different clothing and holster configurations.

Participants are required to provide the following equipment essential to complete the training:

- Semi-automatic duty weapon with 10 round minimum capacity
- Minimum 4 magazines
- 500 rounds of quality ammunition
- Inside the waistband holster
- Outside the waistband holster
- Concealable magazine holster
- Sturdy pants belt
- Ballistic eye protection
- Ear protection
- Concealable bullet resistant vest
- Ball cap
- Pocket sized flashlight with fresh batteries
- Jeans or slacks
- T-shirt or Polo type shirt
- Button up shirt (un-tucked)
- Shell type zippered jacket
- Hooded style sweatshirt
- Water / snacks / lunch
